DOCUMENTARIES



444-Day Face Off (60 mins) **HDTV** In 1981 the US embassy in Tehran, Iran is overrun by university students and an international crisis ensues. In this film, both hostage takers and hostages relate their stories to provide unprecedented firsthand accounts of this historic event. It is a comprehensive look at the Islamic Revolution up to the US embassy takeover told by the people who lived it, highlighting the prospect of future relations between Iran and the US.



Disney Parks (6 x 60 mins) **HDTV** is an unprecedented six-program series that gives viewers special access to top attractions in Disney theme parks throughout the world. With features shot in stunning HD, the series provides exceptional insight into the technology, design, and "imagineering" that goes into every aspect of the Disney experience.



Dragonboat Carnival Hong Kong (60 mins) **HDTV** Viewers are immersed in the history of dragonboats and meet the world's most enthusiastic paddlers, exploring the makeup of this extraordinary phenomenon. Led by three amazing teachers these new age "emigrants" trek through Wyoming and north to Oregon on a once-in-a-lifetime journey that challenges even the toughest in the group.



The Hard Road West (50 mins) **HDTV** This is the true story of the ill-fated Donner party who set out in 1846 for a better life in California but whose journey ended tragically in the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Traveling 2,400 miles by farm wagon, they cross deserts and mountains hoping to reach California in about 5 months. Instead their efforts are undermined by human error and fated by extreme weather. Ravaged by starvation two ordinary families are driven to the very edge of endeavor and endurance.

Mystery Of The Mask (60 mins) **HDTV 3DTV** This Original 3D documentary films is an immersive experience into the rich culture of Lucha Libre, the masked wrestling craze rooted in 1930s Mexico. It's high flying antics, colorful masks and wildly loyal fans have not only become a thriving part of Mexican culture but have spawned legions of new enthusiasts in the US. The film is an honest and introspective examination of this storied tradition. Popular luchadores such as Kayam, the tag-team Los Luchas and others tell us candidly that, though the art form is fun and exciting, the falls are real, the bruises painful, and the scars earned.

Guest musicians include The Beach Boys, Sly and the Family Stone, Alice Cooper, George Lynch of Dokken, Megadeth, Testament, Survivor, Steely Dan, Firehouse, Sister Sledge, Quiet Riot, Vanilla Fudge, Winger, Bob Carlisle, Guns and Roses, Grand Funk Railroad, Kiss, Korn, House of Lords, and Whitesnake just to name a few.

Olympus to Everest (60 mins) Man has been scaling Mt. Everest since the beginning of the 20th Century. Many have reached the summit; many have fallen short. Today, as the number of individuals from many nations trying to scale the mountain grows, countries without an established climbing tradition are taking part. Reinforced by the assistance of the Greek-American celebrity mountaineer Pete Athans, a Greek expedition gains the strength to continue through adversity. Viewers follow the team as they face the hard reality of death in the mountains for a second time. Their team spirit remains the last thing in reserve as they call upon it to realize their vision.



Ploughing Through Time (60 mins) Greek filmmaker Costas Kolimenos decides to take on the controversy of recent Greek civil unrest head on. This unprecedented documentary stands as a unique document for a moment in time that beckons the future of a country in turmoil. The film takes a thrilling look at movements of upheaval and socio-economic conflict, focusing on such small scale protests and their potential for becoming full-fledged revolutions.

The Prize (13 x 30 mins) **HDTV** In this documentary series, viewers go behind the scenes and into the arena with young and ambitious athletes as they compete in their respective sports.
