
Mad About Marriage (26 x 30 mins) **HDTV**


Biz Kid\$ (71 x 30 mins) **HDTV**

Evergreen: The Road to Legalization (90 mins) **HDTV**

A captivating feature documentary on how the citizens of Washington state legalized recreational marijuana for the first time in America, including the groundbreaking effect of this unprecedented citizen initiative on the state, the nation and the world. Evergreen tracks the behind-the-scenes efforts of both the pro-502 and anti-

502 campaigns leading up to the historic vote of approval in November 2012. The film serves as a case study for other states in determining how to reform their own drug policies, examining the civics, economics, precedents and deep human impact of this controversial marijuana legislation. As Washington and Colorado lead the way, many other states are considering cannabis legalization in direct conflict with federal drug laws. This film captures the first wave of a revolutionary sea change in American drug policy.



Go Ganges (60 or 83 mins) **HDTV**

Two friends in a foreign land on a quest to travel the ultimate river. Television producers and adventure travelers Josh Thomas and J.J. Kelley (Paddle to Seattle) test their skills on an epic adventure down India's sacred river, the Ganges. Together they journey from the source glacier of the river in the Himalayas to the Bay of Bengal, where it empties into the Indian Ocean. And they do it rather unconventionally – traveling on foot, cycle-rickshaw, rowboat and anything else that moves. Battling hardships unimaginable to most, the friends test their limits on the planet's most populated, polluted and holy river. The adventurers provide a colorful testimony to the distress the river endures, and why it merits reprieve as an irreplaceable emblem.

Going Long, Going Hard (60 mins) **HDTV**

This film follows athletes engaged in the Epic Camp triathlon camp in New Zealand. The world's top ironman athletes are pitted against the uncompromising New Zealand landscape as they swim, cycle and run 2,200 km through some of the most scenic backdrops in the world, with humor and drama along the way



Gyre: Creating Art from a Plastic Ocean (30 mins) **HDTV**

The world shrinks as we all become connected through our litter, yet somehow we are still severed from the problem we've created, killing the life that depends on the sea. Now, in one of the most breathtaking places on the planet, a unique scientific expedition brings the problem into perspective. National Geographic follows an international team of renowned artists and scientists who journey to Alaska, changing the way we view some of the most disturbingly profound artifacts of our time.



The Hard Road West (50 mins) **HDTV**

This is the true story of the ill-fated Donner party who set out in 1846 for a better life in California but whose journey ended tragically in the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Traveling 2,400 miles by farm wagon, they cross deserts and mountains hoping to reach California in about 5 months. Instead their efforts are undermined by human error and fated by extreme weather. Ravaged by starvation two ordinary families are driven to the very edge of endeavor and endurance.



Into Deepest Space (60 mins) **HDTV**

This program traces the engineering, construction and scientific discoveries of the most powerful observatory on earth, the ALMA telescope in the Chilean Andes. Viewers are taken on a journey both across the globe and throughout the universe to discover how this mammoth radio telescope works and how its observations are revolutionizing astronomy.



In Pursuit of a Dream (60 mins) **HDTV**

This program documents 24 kids from across the US (some who had never been out of their home town) who embark on a journey of wagons, old style clothing and a full settler experience. Led by three amazing teachers these new age "emigrants" trek through Wyoming and north to Oregon on a once-in-a-lifetime journey that challenges even the toughest in the group.



LIGHT Bruce Munro (60 mins) **HDTV**

British artist Bruce Munro's imaginative and innovative installations create a captivating evening experience for visitors to his "Light" exhibitions around the world. This documentary illustrates the artist and designer's career from his first ephemeral outdoor "Field of Light" in Long Knoll Field, Wiltshire, to the artist's other UK exhibitions at Eden Project, V&A, Holbourne Museum, Salisbury Cathedral and Waddeson Manor and US exhibitions at Cheekwood Botanical Gardens, Nashville and Franklin Park Conservatory, Columbus, Ohio.




The Meaning of Wild (30 mins) **HDTV**

This program takes viewers on a journey through one of the planet's wildest landscapes, the Tongass National Forest of Southeast Alaska. The film follows wildlife cameraman Ben Hamilton as he travels by boat, plane, kayak and foot to capture and share the true value of Wilderness. Along the journey, Ben encounters bears, calving glaciers, ancient forests and harsh seas, but it's the characters he meets along the way that bring true insight to his mission.

Myanmar: Bridges to Change (45 mins) **HDTV**

In August 2013 a group of 7 climbers - 5 Americans and 2 Myanmarse - traveled to the farthest reaches of northern Myanmar to make a first ascent of Gamlang Razi, Southeast Asia's disputed highest peak. All told, the climbers traveled over 270 miles on foot through some of the harshest terrain on the planet, braving extreme heat and moisture, as well as the gambit of jungle creatures. Despite these challenges, they were rewarded with rare access to one of the most remote and untouched corners of this planet, living with villagers along the trail that have never seen westerners before. Paddle to Seattle (52 or 86 mins) **HDTV**

Paddle to Seattle: Journey Through the Inside Passage is a documentary chronicling two adventurers as they paddle handmade wooden kayaks along Canada's West coast, from Alaska to Seattle. As they navigate the 1,300 mile inside passage, they encounter brown bears, come frighteningly close to whales and other marine life, and meet the local people.



Papa Boss (60 mins) **HDTV**

Ed Hagerdon has transformed himself from a powerful gangster to a leading environmental warrior, the kind that gains awards and admirers, as well as dangerous enemies. What makes a successful businessman depart from his old lawless ways into fighting miners, illegal fishermen, loggers and gamblers when he himself was one of them in his recent past? When he became the Mayor of Puerto Princesa in 1992, a city of 250,000 inhabitants, surrounded by islands and jungles, the largest territory a city mayor has control of in the Philippines, he vowed to change his life as well as the city, in gratitude to his voters.

IGFA Angler's Digest (26 x 30 mins) **HDTV**

From Alaska to Panama, from Guatemala to Tahiti and all points in between, host Bill Boyce and his talented film crew put viewers in the cockpit of all the boats and operations they fish. Bill's 16 years as a federal fisheries biologist comes into play as he gives not only great technical information on pursuing these treasured gamefish, but his insight and expertise also gives interesting facts about the fish they catch.
